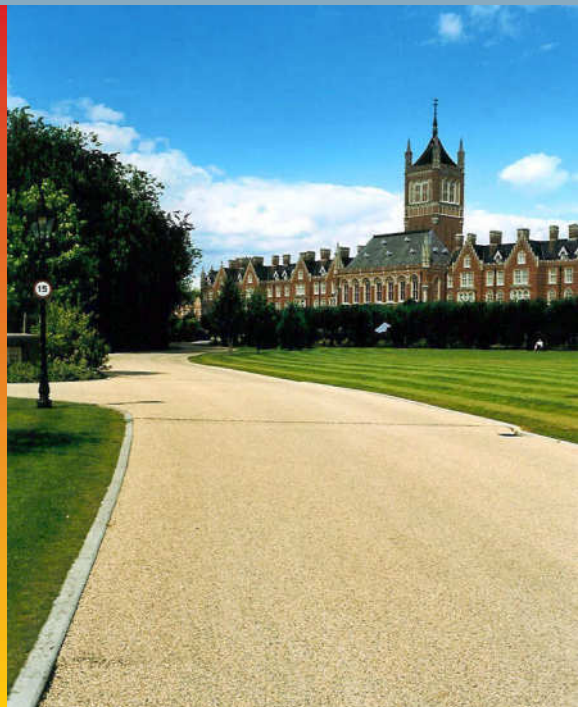

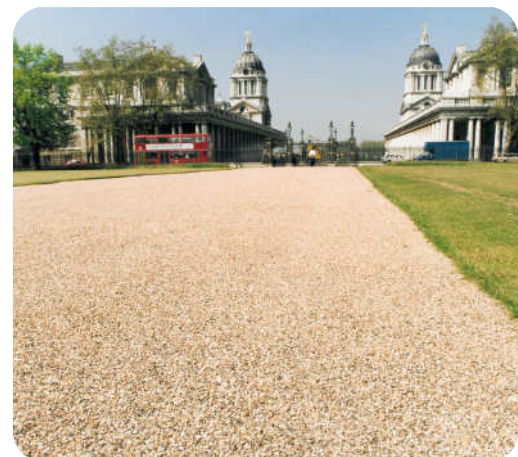

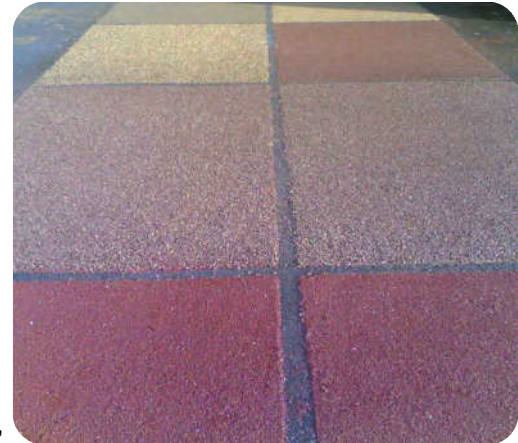


## Coloured Aggregates

There are a number of different variables to consider when making aggregate and resin selection, such as degree of wear and tear expected by either vehicular or pedestrian activities, aesthetic appearance required or specified, and life expectancy of the finished surface. All of these are taken into account to ensure the client is provided with a finished surface suitable for their needs.

Colas can accommodate almost any colour, either natural aggregates or specially coloured to suit either existing surfacing or to blend in naturally with the surrounding buildings or landscape. The most popular choice, particularly from architects, is the natural coloured aggregate which provides excellent durability, low maintenance and aesthetic appearance.

Colas work closely with Architects, Project Managers and Homeowners to ensure information is available as early in the design stage as possible so clients have time to consider different coloured aggregates, Resins (coloured, natural or black), and also finished texture. Samples can be sent out of the various aggregates, or, more commonly, a Colas representative will visit the site to assess requirements and offer suitable aggregate choices.



## Spraygrip

Spraygrip, a bitumen extended epoxy resin, is used in situations where there is potential for high lateral stress caused, for instance, by power steering, by vehicles braking or by high volumes of traffic.

Spraygrip II, a polycarbonate binder, allows high durability Heritage Surfacing to be applied over concrete substrates and gives the option of coloured binders where required.

Colas can provide an alternative to the Heritage Bonded Surfacing when the surface to be laid upon is a type 1 construction with no black top surfacing. A Fibredec system which is a Bitumen emulsion extended with Fibreglass stands to form a homogeneous surface with aggregate of choice spread onto it. Colas are now able to offer Spraygrip 3 as a binder which is classed as a clear Epoxy resin based binder. A clear binder is used instead of black, enabling the binder to be coloured to the clients' specifications.

## Bargate Market

Colas' most recent contracts have been for the London Borough of Richmond where a commendation was achieved for the works carried out at Chalmondely Walk. In addition Colas successfully completed works at Southampton Bargate. The Bargate Friday Market in Southampton is a high profile location adjacent to some historic elements of the City's architecture. This pedestrianised area regularly stages French markets and the Council wanted a surface that would be durable enough to withstand the rigours of market operations whilst also being visually pleasing, enhancing the surrounding area and complimenting the architectural style.

Colas, working in conjunction with Southampton City council and Halcrow as part of the Framework Partnership Contract, proposed its Heritage Surfacing for this environmentally sensitive project. This decorative resin-based system used Spraygrip 2, a flexible polycarbonate binder, with an aggregate of 70% Yellow Gravel and 30% Bauxite. After resurfacing over 1,500m<sup>2</sup> in one week the market was in full swing again on the following day.
